SPEAKER NICHOL: (Microphone not activated.) ...to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. We have with us this morning Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church in Lincoln, and with the difficult days ahead of us I'm sure we expect a very appropriate and thorough message this morning, Dr. Palmer.
