

PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: The Chaplain will present the prayer to us.

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Dr. Palmer. (Gavel.) Members will respond to roll call upon the Clerk's announcement. May we have quiet in the Chamber, please, so that we may hear the roll call. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call taken. See page 53 of the Legislative Journal.) I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum present. The Legislature is in session. Do you have a Journal to refer to for corrections?

CLERK: I do have a Journal, and I also have no corrections to that Journal, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: No corrections to the Journal. Reports, messages and announcements.

CLERK: I have no messages, reports or announcements at this time, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are we faced with LB 1, on General File, is that where we are on the agenda?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, LB 1 was offered by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read.) The bill was read for the first time on September 19 of this year. It was referred to the Business and Labor Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no committee amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Speaker, Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I think it is no secret to all of you why we are here, to insert four words that should have been in the bill when we passed it in the general session at the early part of 1985.
