SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. We have with us this morning Farmer Robert Palmer of the Presbyterian Church in Lincoln, Westminster Presbyterian Church. Dr. Palmer.
