

SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: We'll have invocation this morning by our Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church of Lincoln. Dr. Palmer.

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you again, Dr. Palmer. Roll call please. Senator Lundy, would you push my green button, please. I'm off the air this morning. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Would you announce the numerous corrections to the Journal, please.

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh, okay. Do you have any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 29 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments attached. (See pages 172-73 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Vickers to be inserted. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: That's very good. We'll move on to General File. I have included both LB 35, with the emergency clause attached, and LB 10, with the emergency clause attached. We'll call on Senator Warner to decide for us which one of these two he wishes to take this up with. How's that for a sentence to start Tuesday morning off with. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 35 be advanced. I think it ought to be advanced. I realize that similar language is found in...the same language is found in LB 10. There seems to be some question, I think, yet as to which of the two bills is most appropriate. Until that...in order to have additional time for members to determine which
