SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Invocation this morning by Dr. Robert Palmer of the Presbyterian Church. Dr. Palmer.

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you, Dr. Palmer. Roll call, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No, sir, not this morning.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you have any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance, whose Chair is Senator John DeCamp, to whom was referred LB 1 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with committee amendments attached. Mr. President, I might add that members will find a copy of those committee amendments on their desk. (See pages 61-3 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LR 2 is ready for your signature. I do have a request from Senator Richard Peterson to add his name as co-introducer.

SPEAKER NICHOL: No objection, so ordered. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 2.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a report of Registered Lobbyists, an interim report, actually, from the weeks of April 17, 1986 through November 14, 1986, and, finally, Mr. President, I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator John DeCamp.
