

SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church for our invocation. Dr. Palmer.

DR. PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Dr. Palmer, we have appreciated your messages during this special session. We, again, thank you again. Good luck to you. Roll call, please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Quorum is present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any corrections to the Journal, this morning?

CLERK: No, sir, no corrections.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 5 is ready for your signature.

SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 5. Senator Tim Hall, I saw you come in a moment ago, were you ready to go on your resolution at this time? So that you will know what will be happening today, generally, we will take the Final Reading ahead of the reports. I think, by the time we get to the end of the first bill, most of us will be here. Then, after that, the Governor is out of the city until some time this afternoon, so will not appear before you today. After our session, we'll provide plaques and so forth for those who will not be returning next year, but not...okay, skip that. Wait and find out. All right. (Gavel.) If I could have your attention a moment, Senator Hall has a resolution for us at this time.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hall's resolution is found on page 111 of the Legislative Journal. (LR 6.)

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, members, this resolution was brought to me by a group of people who work in the emergency medical services area across the state. They are asking for a public hearing, and that is basically all the resolution does is ask the Health and Human Services Committee of the Nebraska
