SPEAKER NICHOL: Will you please rise while we have invocation by Dr. Robert Palmer, please.

DR. ROBERT PALMER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you have introduction of any new bills, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have one new bill. LB 5 offered by Senator Schmit. (Read LB 5 by title for the first time. See page 16 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, Senator Warner, would you like to have any instructions given to your committee, or do they know it, or for the benefit of those who might wish to attend your hearings, would you like to say a word to us as to when and where they are and what time we are invited to attend your hearings?

I suspect that we do have some additional agencies that were in addition to the list that was put out yesterday for specific items that will come up late in the afternoon.
