SPEAKER BARRETT: (Microphone not activated) to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber on this the 18th day of the first session of the Ninetieth Nebraska State Legislature. We will proceed to General File. Senator Moore, the introducer of LB 140, is excused until he arrives. I would suggest that we move to LB 150. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 150 was introduced by Senator Miller. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 9 of this year, referred to the Natural Resources Committee for hearing, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
