PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Mike not activated immediately)...Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning Reverend Howard Holverson of the Christian Church, Disciples of Christ in Lincoln. Would you please rise for the invocation.
