PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated) ...the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning Reverend Frank Munkel of the Christ Unity Church in Lincoln. Would you please rise for Reverend Munkel's...

REVEREND F. MUNKEL: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Reverend Munkel, for coming to us this morning. We appreciate it. Roll call, please.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do we have any corrections to the Journal today?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Okay, do you have any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: I have no messages, reports and/or announcements, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, looks like we're ready to go to General File then, doesn't it?

CLERK: Yes, sir, it does.

PRESIDENT: Okay, we'll pick up with LB 780. If you would fill us in where we were when we left it a few days ago, we would appreciate that.

CLERK: Mr. President, 780 is on General File. It's the mainline appropriations bill. It was introduced by the members of the Appropriations Committee. The bill was introduced on April 24, referred directly to General File. To date, there has been an amendment adopted to the bill by Senators Withem and Baack. When the bill was discussed on Friday, Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson had offered an amendment to the bill. That amendment is pending. Senator Johnson is excused until he arrives.
