PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Recorder not activated immediately) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning Father Jay Gabb of the Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Lincoln. Would you please rise for the convocation.

FATHER JAY GABB: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Father Gabb, for our invocation this morning. We appreciate it. Come back and see us again sometime, please. Roll call please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do we have any corrections to the Journal today?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Landis regarding LB 663. (See pages 2411-15 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have an explanation of vote from Senator Wehrbein. Mr. President, Senator Lynch would like to have a meeting of the Rules Committee, a public hearing, for purposes of discussing the proposed rule change 1453 found in the Journal on page 2399. That proposed rule change was submitted yesterday, Mr. President, and also involves a hearing on Senator Lamb's proposal. That hearing will be at 9:30 this morning in Room 2102, Rules Committee hearing at 9:30 this morning in Room 2102. That is offered by Senator Lynch as Chair of the committee. And, Mr. President, that is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: If I could have your attention a minute, the Speaker has asked me to announce that number 9 on your agenda, which has a familiar number under it I am sure you will recognize, 775, will not be discussed today. The agenda was set up before the end of yesterday's activities and it was anticipated that perhaps we'd not be as far with it as today, so that will not be discussed today. And I think you heard the Clerk say that at nine-thirty there is a hearing of the members of this body to discuss a rule change in the old Judiciary room, what is that
