PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us, as our chaplain of the day, Mr. Robert Rudell with the Department of Social Services and is also minister at the Immanuel Church in Lincoln. Mr. Rudell, please. Would you please rise.
