

PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber. We have with us this morning as our chaplain of the day, Father Sam Bowman of St. David's Episcopal Church in Lincoln. Would you please rise for the invocation.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, whose Chair is Senator Baack, would report LB 1136 to General File. That is signed by Senator Baack. Natural Resources Committee would report LB 151, LB 1062, LB 1063, and LB 1090 as indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Schmit as Chair.

Mr. President, I have a request from Senator Miller to add his name to LB 1123 as co-introducer. I have gubernatorial appointment letter appointing Alan Dillman to the Nebraska Agricultural Land Valuation Advisory Board.

Mr. President, I have a series of designation of priority bills. Senator Haberman, as Chair of Retirement, would move or ask for 879 to be a committee priority bill. Senator Baack would ask that 1167 be a Government Committee priority bill. Senator Rogers has chosen 943 as his personal priority bill. Senator Rod Johnson has designated 913 as his priority bill.

Mr. President, I have received a report from the State Claims Board regarding the Office of Risk Management/State Claims Board. That will be on file in my office for member review.
