PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning, Reverend Harland Johnson. Would you please rise for the invocation.

REVEREND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Harland, appreciate that. Roll call, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: How about messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk did present to the Governor as of Friday, 12:20 p.m., bills read on Final Reading that day. (Re: LB 475, LB 871, LB 519 and LB 845. See page 1060 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Hall has amendments to LB 1127 to be printed. (See pages 1061-62 of the Legislative Journal.) And that is all that I have.

PRESIDENT: Shall we move on to the resolution number 295.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 295 is a resolution offered by Senator McFarland. It is found on page 1027 of the Journal. (Read explanation of LR 295.)

PRESIDENT: Senator McFarland, please.

SENATOR MCFARLAND: Mr. President, fellow senators, it is indeed a pleasure to introduce this resolution honoring Betty Loudon as the Nebraska Mother of the Year. Betty is a person who resides in the district I represent. As a matter of fact, she lives a block and a half from me. Her son, Timothy Loudon, is a friend of mine. He is also a lawyer.
