PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning, as chaplain of the day, Reverend Homer Clements of the St. Lukes Methodist Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. Would you please rise for the invocation.
