SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: Welcome to this the fourth day of the First Special Session of the 90th Legislature. The opening prayer this morning by our colleague from the 15th Legislative District, Senator Lowell Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)
