PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Aaron Black of First Methodist Church in Lincoln. Pastor Black.

PASTOR BLACK: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Black. I now call to order the seventh day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Journal is approved. Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: The committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 871 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments attached. I have received a Reference Report from the Reference Committee referring LBs 1065 through 1104, as well as a rereferral of LB 1040, and a referral of LR 220. I have also received from the Central Platte NRD a report of payment of attorney fees this past year required to be filed pursuant to statute. That is all that I have at this time, Madam President.
