PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen. (Gavel.) Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Chaplain Harland Johnson.

REVEREND HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)
