PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our Chaplain is Senator Merton "Cap" Dierks of the 40th Legislative District. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Dierks. I now call to order the Third Day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, First Special Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you. We will proceed with Item 4 on the agenda, General File. Do you have some messages and announcements, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, I do. I have a communication from the Governor withdrawing a certain gubernatorial appointee for confirmation hearing. I have two notice of hearings, one from Health and Human Services chaired by Senator Wesely, a confirmation hearing by Natural Resources chaired by Senator Johnson. Madam President, new resolution, LR 9CA introduced by Senator Hall. (Read brief explanation. See pages 55-56 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be referred to Reference Committee. Pursuant to that introduction, Madam President, I have a Reference Report referring LR 9CA to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. That is all that I have, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We will now proceed with General File.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 2 was a bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on July 8, referred directly to General File,
