SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good afternoon, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer we have Harland Johnson. Harland.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Pursuant to a Proclamation issued by the Honorable E. Benjamin Nelson, Governor of Nebraska, we are here and now assembled in the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Special Session of the Nebraska Legislature. I, as President of the Legislature, declare that we are now open for the transaction of business. Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a quorum present.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Would you please read the Proclamation.

CLERK: (Read the Proclamation. See page 3 of the Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, members have copies of the Proclamation on their desk.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Warner, you have a motion. Just a second, Senator Warner, we're having trouble with the microphones here. Senator Warner. Could you move over to the other mike and see if that one works, Senator Warner. Senator Warner. Would the Clerk please read the motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move that the following officers be elected to serve for the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Special Session. Clerk, Patrick J. O'Donnell; Assistant Clerk, Richard K. Brown, Sergeant At Arms, Carl E. Kamprath; Chaplain Coordinator, Harland Johnson.
