SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good afternoon, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us today for the prayer we have Harland Johnson. Harland.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Harland. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Pursuant to a proclamation issued by the Honorable E. Benjamin Nelson, Governor of Nebraska, we are here and now assembled in the Ninety-Second Legislature, Third Special Session of the Nebraska Legislature. I, as acting President of the Legislature, declare that we are now open for the transaction of business. Mr. Clerk, election of officers. Mr. Clerk, would you read the proclamation, please.
