PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: (Microphone not activated) ...ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Senator Lowell Johnson of the 15th Legislative District.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)
