SENATOR HALL: I move that the nominations be closed and Senator Will be elected by acclamation.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. You've heard the motion. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The motion carries. Congratulations to Senator Will as Chair of the Rules Committee. Thank you. We will now proceed with nominations for Enrollment and Review Chair. Senator Will.
