SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: (Response inaudible.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there further discussion of the amendment? Senator Pirsch, did you wish to say something?

SENATOR PIRSCH: I guess I am not really clear and I don't believe others are clear. Senator Fisher, what you are saying is that you wish to withdraw your amendment to exchange Government for Judiciary or Judiciary for Government?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Fisher, you may respond.

SENATOR FISHER: It is not my understanding that I am withdrawing. It is my understanding that that transfer wasn't approved by the Committee of Committees, and I abide by their decision, period.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay. Well, I think, in essence, that does and, of course, I have nothing more to say about that issue. I certainly will speak to the Committee on Committees report.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you. Further discussion on the amendment, Senator Chambers, did you wish to discuss the amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I am going to try to see if I understand what is happening here. There is a report before us that was offered by the Committee on Committees pursuant to what happened earlier this morning. What Senator Pirsch had desired earlier was to be moved from one committee to the Judiciary Committee and she had an agreement with another senator to accomplish that. The other senator has stated that whatever decision the Committee on Committees made when it went to reconsider the matter would be satisfactory with him, and he agreed with what the Committee on Committees decided. Based on the way, and here is where I have to be clear, based on what I understand the Committee on Committees decision to be, that trade is not now a part of the Committee on Committees report. So the Committee on Committees left Senator Pirsch where she had been assigned, left Senator Fisher where he was assigned. So if I understand Senator Fisher correctly, he would not be offering an amendment to change what the Committee on Committees report has done. So if he is accepting what the Committee on Committees has done, it would mean that he is not a
