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ET did, that EC did phone home. But that aside, I would say that our practice of allowing people to make dibs on what committees they would like to serve on is, in fact, a courtesy rather than a mandate, that the members of the Committee on Committees are entrusted with the responsibility from their caucus to see that their caucus is represented in the committees of the Legislature in the best manner that they see at the time that they are doing that. My suggestion, Senator Robinson's suggestion was only to extend the period of time that would make the courtesy portion more readily applicable and to see that after the leadership positions, after the Appropriations Committee selections are made that there is again an opportunity for the caucus representatives to recaucus with their group and see if there are any final changes made before the final vote. I do think at some point in time the recommendation of the Committee on Committees need be taken as a whole without amendment because we have already entrusted our members from our caucus with that responsibility. At some point in time we must accept that and I think this is that point in time and we need to move on to the other business before the body. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I would call the question.

SPEAKER BAACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. We will now vote on ceasing debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Debate has ceased. I will go to Senator Crosby to close on the Committee on Committee report.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and thank everyone for the discussion and I appreciate your being here to hear that and discuss and participate in it. The Committee on Committees, I will appoint a small subcommittee to work on the things that we discussed this morning having to do with rule changes. Just remember, rule changes don't happen tomorrow. The Rules Committee has to take that and look at it and hear it and so on. So some things were said here this morning, I just wanted to reassure everybody that this report stands when you vote on it today. So I close now and ask you to vote yes on the report
