SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer today we have Chaplain Harland Johnson. Harland.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Harland. I now call to order the seventh day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. Roll call. Mr. Clerk.
