SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us as chaplain today we have Pastor Larry Michael-Rush from the Ceresco Methodist Church, from Senator Hudkins' district. Pastor.
