

48 percent. We have no objection to someone wishing to identify kegs. Some form of identification, if it is reasonably good care, we certainly are not objecting. So, here is a person who's representing a distributor says, we have no problem identifying a keg. In your packet you will find a letter from the State of Washington. While this system is not a "pancrea" for...of all problems related to illegal use of alcohol by minors, it certainly goes a long way toward stemming keg parties which, traditionally, have created more problems than other forms of consumption. So, I would ask your support for LB 332.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Haberman. Mr. Clerk, an amendment.

CLERK: Senator Schellpeper, I...I have misconstrued, you want to offer your amendment?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schellpeper would move to amend Senator Haberman's amendment. (Schellpeper amendment appears on page 1113 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. Senator Haberman passed out his amendment, and my amendment basically will, on page 1 it would strike Section 2 where it says that beer appears to be the most popular alcoholic beverage throughout the state. I don't know whether we can actually say that. I think we need to just take the section out, that whole Section 2 would come out. I think when you start coming in and saying that beer is the most problem, or alcohol is the most problem, if it'd say alcohol, I think I could live with it, but I don't like to come in and say that...just say beer appears to be, because we don't really, really know that. And then the rest of the...of my amendment, wherever there's any reference to any keg identification number it would be stricken. On page 1, line 22 and 23, it says the keg identification number; on page 2 we would strike the whole paragraph that has...starts with the commission itself adopt, that whole section would be gone through line 20. And then in line 21 and 22, where it talks about the keg identification number for each container shall be registered with the commission, that would be stricken. Line 27, the bottom of the page, any person who unlawfully
