

pro...Senator Haberman, would you like to close? He waives closing. We will proceed with the vote on Senator Haberman's amendment to LB 332. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on Senator Haberman's amendment to LB 332. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Haberman's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Hartnett would move to amend. The amendment is on page 1123 of the Journal.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Chairman, Mr. Speaker, I guess, my amendment is found on the middle part of page 1123. All it simply says is the commission, Liquor Commission shall issue a report to the Legislature on or before December 1st of each year commencing on December 1, 19...concerning the effectiveness of keg registration legislation on deterring use of alcoholic liquor by minors and other issues relating to the keg registration, and may include recommendation to improve the effectiveness of such legislation. I guess I checked a different source than Senator Haberman dealing with the State of Washington. And I think we simply need this, as I think, brings some accountability into the legislation. Is it really working, or can we make it better? And I think that is really the purpose of it in doing this. I think there has been, from my source in Washington, it is...with the keg, it has driven some of the fraternities and so forth to use bottles and cans rather than kegs. But I think I simply want the liquor commission to report back to the Legislature is this keg registration working. So, with that, I'd ask the body to support this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. On the Hartnett amendment, Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I cosponsored this amendment with Senator Hartnett. I don't think it's any secret that I'm not particularly fond of this piece of legislation, but I think with the Hartnett amendment that, as I
