

understanding not just of the members of this body, but also the Attorney General relative to boot camps. He has indicated he did not intend for that to be how it is drafted. He wants it to be sort of an alternative to incarceration and I think it is not clearly drafted in that respect in the present form so we do intend to come back and fix that and then we'll have an amendment or a series of amendments where we can really have the full debate on the issues, particularly post conviction, time lines, limiting that and take up some time relative to debate on Select File rather than General File. So I think, assure the body that there will be some consideration. I know some people may feel that we've taken some stuff out of this that ought to go back in. I think we'll have an amendment that will put a good part of this back in the bill and additionally some things that the committee amendments frankly did not have in them which will primarily be issues that are resolved. And then we'll have the second stage of the Select File debate which will be the debate frankly on the issues that we are not in agreement on and we'll have the full floor debate on that and let the body be involved completely in those issues and take those issues, maybe one or two, or perhaps three one at a time for full consideration by the body on Select File. So I do rise in support of the amendment to the amendments and then the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hohenstein. Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President, colleagues, I also rise in support of the amendments. Senator Chambers has talked to a number of the members, a number of the sponsors of the bill and it's the conclusion of the majority of the members that support the bill that we're going to deal with the bill in this particular approach. The sections that will probably be revisited will be as Senator Hohenstein stated, portions that will be agreed upon and portions that may not be agreed upon between Senator Chambers and the sponsors of the bill. But it is our hope by taking this approach that we can find a ground that we can agree on and pass a piece of legislation that the body can be proud of. Thank you.
