SENATOR ABOUD: The bill itself as it was structured prior to Senator Chambers' (inaudible).

SENATOR ROBAK: Yes, I understand that, but you're not going to reattach those portions of the bill that we took out during our exec session.

SENATOR ABOUD: Well, I'll be happy...if they can be acceptable to myself, to Senator Chambers, to yourself, yeah, I wouldn't...I'll agree to do that.

SENATOR ROBAK: Because, also I...

SENATOR ABOUD: I can't imagine that your standard will be any higher...

SENATOR ROBAK: I like the concept of the boot camp and I think we discussed that at the time because there needs to be a place for not necessarily juvenile offenders, but young offenders that...so they would not have to go to the correctional center.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mmm, hmm.

SENATOR ROBAK: And that was my main reason for advancing this bill. However, if we stick all these things back in there, I will have to tell you right now I can't support the bill. Thank
