SENATOR LANDIS: I've got my light on.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, maybe mine was on first. Let me ask Senator Beutler a question, if he's here. Senator Beutler, do you support this amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Senator Wesely. Oh, he's not here. Senator Warner. No, you're for 579, you're not in this. Senator Wesely, do you support this amendment? Senator Wesely, I would like you to say it on the mike.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I support the amendment. I don't support the Landis amendment. I support your amendment to the Landis amendment.
