PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Does anyone else wish to speak to the amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Vrtiska? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Vrtiska amendment to LB 593. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
