General File, and Senator Priority Bills, and LB 332A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 332A was a bill introduced by Senator Haberman. (Read title.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the body, this appropriates \$7,000 from the General Fund to start 332 on its way. It does have anymore...does not have any more General Fund appropriations, and I ask for the advancement of 332A. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR HABERMAN: And if you do not believe me, I'd appreciate if you'd call me a liar so I can say that I'll get the record and prove it to you.

SENATOR HALL: No, I...I am turning the other cheek and becoming a kinder, gentler legislator after the editorial this morning. But, anyway, can you tell me about Section 2 of the A bill.
