SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Haberman. You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 332A. We'll now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 332A. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 332A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 332A advances. We'll go to LB 301A.

CLERK: LB 301A, Mr. President, a bill by Senator Beutler. (Read title.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is the 301, the water rights bill. It has a fiscal note on it, as you will note, for \$88,000 for the next fiscal year, and \$80,000 for the succeeding fiscal year. And it has to do with providing appropriate personnel to conduct the hearings and to conduct the research necessary as...that is necessary as a part of the hearing. I'd ask for the advancement of the bill.
