

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam President, members, I'd simply ask that the bill be advanced to Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You heard the motion to advance LB 131A. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 131A is advanced. We will now proceed with Select File, LB 364.

CLERK: LB 364, Madam President, the first item I have are Enrollment and Review amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 364.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You heard the motion to adopt E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Wehrbein would move to amend. (See AM0870 on page 1019 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam Speaker and members, this is basic...I'd call them almost technical amendments brought by bill drafting. They are just slightly more than technical so they couldn't be handled in E & R, but far from substantive, and has no effect on the bill or its impact. They were recommended changes by the bill drafting. They are on page 1019. As I said, the first one clarifies the definition of an ethanol facility; and the second one is a part that was overlooked in the original drafting, it just explains what the fund is. So as I said, they are not substantive but they are enough different from technical that bill drafting recommended we run the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Does anyone wish to speak to the amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Wehrbein amendment to LB 364. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Wehrbein amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
