SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good afternoon and welcome to the George...good afternoon and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Roll call.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. My understanding is we are on a motion to overrule the Chair, correct?

CLERK: We were, yes, sir.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, notwithstanding my feelings about the substance of the matter, I would like to withdraw that and get on to the discussion of the amendment, because I think that's what the body wants.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. It is withdrawn. We are back on the amendment by Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you like to give us just a quick update of your amendment, please.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. And, yes, it is possible that even Senator Bernard-Stevens can get a brief update on an amendment. The amendment would change the Industrial and Commercial Water Act that would clearly define that commercial and public golf courses that maintain turf would be included in that section.
