

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: (Inaudible) ...if I may.

SPEAKER BAACK: Reverse order roll call vote has been requested.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Roll call.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call, yes. It's hard to a reverse order machine vote. The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. We are looking for Senator Ashford. All members are now present, and we have had a request for a reverse order roll call. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1249 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 17 nays.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. I will raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (Beutler amendment, AM1164, appears on pages 1249-50 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, it seems that the Legislature does want to do something with this particular item, and I don't want to let the occasion pass without offering you the opportunity to do what the committee thought was the proper approach to this. And it seems like you want to put into this bill and you want to deal with the transfer for golf courses. And so what I am offering your now and will be passed out to you, as soon as they can reproduce it, is basically the committee bill. It strikes the Bernard-Stevens amendment and substitutes the committee bill. And basically it says, yes, you can transfer water for the purpose of a golf course, all you have to do is apply to the Director of Water Resources and have a hearing on it, and if, after both sides have discussed the issue, the director thinks that the criteria of the statute had been met, the same criteria that everybody else that transfers the property has to meet...transfers water has to meet, if it's been met then, yes, it can transfer.
