LB 794, indefinitely postponed; LB 795, indefinitely postponed; LB 796, indefinitely postponed; and LB 802 and LB 809, all indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Wesely as Chair of the committee. That's all that I have. (See pages 1256-57 of the Legislative Journal.)

CLERK: LB 526, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I move the advancement of LB 526 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 526. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 726.

CLERK: LB 726, Senator, I have E & R, first of all.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hohenstein.
