

other, that I think are very important issues to myself and members of my community and many of these I campaigned on and many of these, if you look into your own campaigns, the new senators and possibly some of the senators who have been here a while, when you go back into the communities this is what you talk to the people about. You talk about keeping the neighborhood safe, you talk about lowering the crime rates and yet when you get here on the floor all I see is a lot of wheeling and dealing in trying to defeat this bill anyway that can be done. So I want to give the people who sincerely would like to see these parts of this bill, the opportunity to vote on that and I would ask you to defeat the bracket motion and allow me the opportunity to offer these, just these four amendments and I appreciate your time. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Witek. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, after Senator Witek has been here a while and learned something she will know the difference between wheeling and dealing and an effort by people who have worked very, very hard and put in a lot of time to try to resolve some serious issues off the floor of the Legislature instead of taking the time to try to rewrite a bill on the floor that should have been more properly written before it was introduced. Now she is carrying water for somebody outside the Legislature and as a result of that, she comes here beating her gums about people wheeling and dealing and trying to kill this bill. First of all, she is not speaking for me. Maybe she is talking about Senator Hohenstein and Senator Abboud and Senator Ashford because we're the ones who have been working on it. So far not one of those men has told me that his intent is to kill this bill. So far not one of them has told me that his intent is to delay the bill simply for the purpose of delay. When people talk about that which they know nothing, they reveal the truth of that statement that a little knowledge is a dangerous thing and even less knowledge can be a fatal thing. As time goes on, the members begin to find out pretty quickly who those people are who really are trying to do something that will facilitate the movement of legislation and those who allow them to become tools, themselves to be tools of people outside the Legislature. If you want to take the four amendments up, it makes me no difference. But I have said from the beginning when this bill came out here and I said it in the Judiciary Committee when they sent it out here, I'm going to fight against those propositions
