PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Pastor Robert Swanson of Havelock Christian Church in Lincoln, Senator Landis' district. Pastor Swanson.

PASTOR SWANSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Swanson. I now call to order the sixty-third day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Journal is approved. Are there any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Just two, a report from the Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards on file in the Clerk's office and LR 78 is ready for your signature, Madam President. That's all that I have.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 78. Next on the agenda is Item 5, General File. We'll start with LB 757.

CLERK: 757, Madam President, when the Legislature last discussed it yesterday there was pending an amendment by Senator Landis. If I may, it was an amendment that dealt with the safety committees. The amendment was offered. I have a series of amendments to the amendment, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Landis, would you like to refresh us about the safety committees?
