SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE:    Yes, Mr. Speaker, and members, LB 831 is the early deficit bill, has the item in it for additional money for the County Automation Project we discussed before. This motion is simply a rule suspensor motion to read the bill today so we can get the money over to the people who need it. There is a...you know, there would be a question on whether or not you need this rule suspension motion. I think just to be on the safe side and to reiterate that this is a unique situation, I simply ask the body to suspend the rules so we can read the bill today.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Discussion on the rule suspension?    Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS:    I rise to support Senator Moore in his attempt to suspend the rules and to read before the budget this appropriations bill. I think he's made an excellent case and I join him in wanting to pass 831 this morning.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Thank you, Senator Landis. Any other discussion on the motion to suspend the rules? Seeing none, Senator Moore, would you like to close?

SENATOR MOORE:    Simply ask for suspension of the rules.

SPEAKER BAACK:    We will now vote on the rule suspension. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK:    36 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER BAACK:    The rules are suspended. We will now read LB 831. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK:    (Read LB 831 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK:    All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 831 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
