CLERK:      25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    The amendment is adopted.

CLERK:      I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Does anyone else wish to speak to the bill itself? Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN:    I move the advancement of LB 423 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've all heard the motion to advance LB 423. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 423 is advanced. Before we proceed, I would like to call the senators' attention to the south balcony. Special guests today of Senator Vrtiska are 14 members of AARP in Pawnee County and their president. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Chamber. Thank you. Next bill is LB 216.

CLERK:      I have E & R amendments, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN:    I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 216.

PRESIDENT MOUL:    You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK:      Senator Landis would move to amend with AM782. (Landis amendment, AM782, appears on page 964 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL:    Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS:    Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. And, Mr. Clerk, you identified that as amendment 782? Thank you very much. This is a bill that alters the Nebraska Securities Act, and after we advanced it from General File the committee heard from the Nebraska Life Underwriters Association who thought that the investment advisor definition was too broad, requiring them to comply with an act when they
