

creditor. Now, we strike the phrase post office, making it the name and the address. Not everyone has a post office address. Secondly, we strike a provision that says, no execution or other process for enforcement of a foreign judgment filed hereunder shall ensue until after 30 days after the date the judgment is filed. That sentence is struck. Why? Under existing law, if you have a foreign judgment, you come to this state, somebody's been trying to elude you, it's possible to at least hold the property until you determine whether or not it should be available for execution. And by...by putting in this language, it's possible to build in a 30-day buffer and allowing somebody to escape and go to a different jurisdiction. In that sense, if it gets interpreted that way, it would defeat part of the virtue of the bill. I would ask for the advancement or the adoption of this minor technical amendment, and then I believe Senator Lindsay has a more substantial amendment which will be explained to you in a moment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Landis. Does anyone wish to address the Landis amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing?

SENATOR LANDIS: Only to say that I support the Lindsay amendment and its adoption to the bill and then the advancement of the bill, although I may not be present when that occurs. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Landis. We will now vote on the motion to adopt the Landis amendment to LB 458. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the Landis amendment? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.
