CLERK:      LB 690, Senator, no E & R. Senator Moore does have an amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

CLERK:      Senator, your amendment is on page 1537 of the Journal. 1537.

SENATOR MOORE: On LB 690?

CLERK:      Mmm, hmm.

SENATOR MOORE: Okay, I'd better look my amendment up then. Oh, okay, now I'm remembering this. Excuse me, members of the body, LB 690 was a bill dealing with how we can use the title of professional engineers and architects. What my amendment does is simply add to that the area of surveyors. There is a similar problem there with surveyors where a company may advertise that they have a licensed surveyor or they are a licensed surveyor or professional surveyor. When they're not, they may have someone under contract but that someone may well be outside the confines of the State of Nebraska, and so really it's the same exact issue under LB 690, but it includes surveyors in that definition as well. So that's simply what the amendment is and I'd ask for the adoption of the amendment by the body.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Does anyone wish to address the Moore amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Moore?

SENATOR MOORE: No, I just thank the Clerk for reminding me that I had this amendment up there. Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. We will now vote on the Moore amendment to LB 690. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Moore amendment? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.
