SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. No, I just ask to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Crosby. We will now vote on the motion to return LB 292. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is adopted. We are at Select File. Senator Crosby, for opening on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Madam President. I've already explained the amendment on my prior motion, and I just ask that you vote to move it back to Final Reading again. I think this is indicative of the work that the PERB office and the actuaries and everyone go over these bills with a fine-toothed comb to be sure when they come out that they are going to work properly and that people that they serve will be served in the correct way. So as Senator Horgan explained, too, we just wanted to be sure that these dates were correct, so when the bill does become law, it will work the way it is supposed to. So, thank you very much for voting to move it on to Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Crosby amendment to LB 292. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.
