

to do. So, this really is a little bit more comprehensive and is more...is directed more towards the problem. The only difference, really, is the \$50 fine. And I...I guess, I mean we have to either vote that up or down. It seems to me that if...I don't know how else to enforce it. I mean, I don't know how else to get people to do it, other than to have some kind of a fine in there. But I...I..

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, that's...that's the part of the amendment that I really have a problem with is Section 3. Would you agree to the amendment if Section 3 was taken out?

SENATOR ASHFORD: I'd agree to the amendment, if you can get it off. I'm not going to agree to take it off. I mean, if you want to file...I mean, if we want to have a vote that whether or not to have a fine, that's fine. Let's just have a vote up or down on whether there ought to be a fine for not giving out the information. And if that vote is successful, then we'll run the amendment without it. But I'd like to see what the body's...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, I guess, I thought we had an agreement that we were going to run the amendment on 627. And I realize that bill is having some problems. And I'd have no problem if you wanted to run that amendment on LB 117, that same amendment. But now you're coming in with a different amendment that adds Section 3, that was not in our agreement that we were going to run on LB 627, and that's what bothers me. I don't think that LB...that Section 3 is really needed at this time, and that was not part of the agreement that we had between the parties involved. So, I guess at this time, if Senator Ashford is not willing to run the other amendment that was an agreed upon amendment, or else take out Section 3, I will have to oppose returning to Select File, because I think when you make an agreement you should stick to it. And we thought we had one, and it was agreeable...agreeable with everyone involved, and now we see a different amendment that is not agreeable. So, I will oppose to return to Select File at this time. Thank you.
