How will we know that it's being done? Maybe if there were some conditions in here that we would be able to reexamine this issue some time into the future it would be helpful. But I'll turn the rest of my time over to Senator Ashford, and have him have a chance to respond to Senator Schellpeper as well.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Schellpeper, let me ask you, could I you a question about what the NRAs real position is here?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Part of the problem that I've had is...is understanding exactly what the NRA's position on this stuff is, because they...they sort of don't tell me. So, you...you tell me.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: I think they actually tell you, but you won't listen.

SENATOR ASHFORD: No, I don't think that's...that's right. I mean, you tell me and that's one thing, but then they don't come back with what they're going to come back with. But be that as it may, if we strike Section 3, is it your understanding that the NRA will cooperate by helping to distribute these...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, definitely.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Definitely.

SENATOR ASHFORD: And that the creation of this fund is...is a real thing,...
