I also salute those people who have worked outside of this body to bring some assistance and support to those people who are suffering these atrocities. I particularly am pleased that the Croatian Cultural Society has been working diligently to send clothing and other humanitarian support to that country and is willing to become involved in peaceful ways to help those people who are dealing with this kind of trauma. This morning, for me particularly, has been very emotional, having dealt with the previous resolution and now this one which brings many things to mind. I stand in support of the bracket motion so that we can begin to address all of the concerns that are here to help, at a national scale, address a tragic and very important and difficult solution to this problem. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Preister. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the reason I object is because I have to correct the record. We're talking about Bosnia-Herzegovina, and I continue to say the Bosnians. The Serbians are the ones doing the fighting and committing the atrocities, so I must correct the record in that regard. And having said that, I withdraw my objection, if that is allowable.
