SPEAKER BAACK:      Any discussion of the committee amendments to LB 345?    Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Senator Warner, if I may, just a question.    On Section 28 of the bill, the civil penalty of \$1,000 for improperly stating the amount of sales tax due on a sale of a motor vehicle, could you just explain briefly how that changes current law or what that...how that affects...what change that affects in the current law?

SPEAKER BAACK:      Senator Warner.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    And is that penalty...

SENATOR WARNER:    Yes, Senator Beutler, I hadn't got to the bill itself.    But, as I recall, there is no penalty now for improperly filling out the sales tax amount due and this puts a penalty into effect.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Okay, and is that...

SENATOR WARNER:    That's in the bill itself now, not part of the committee amendments.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    The committee, yes, okay.    And is that...is that regardless of whether it's done intentionally or accidentally?

SENATOR WARNER:    Got to look at the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Oh, I'm sorry, I can wait, Senator, if that would be more helpful.    Senator Warner, why don't I...if you're organized to deal with the bill, why not wait?    I'll hang on, Mr. Speaker, for a second here.

SPEAKER BAACK:      Thank you, Senator Beutler.    Any other discussion on the committee amendments?    Seeing none, Senator Warner, do you wish to close on the committee amendments.    He waives closing.    We will now vote on the committee amendments to LB 345.    All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.    Record, Mr. Clerk.
